Who we are

Turning Point is committed to being a leader in the field of addiction treatment in New Jersey. It was recognized by the White House as a model program when the nationwide Access to Recovery Treatment Initiative was announced at a Turning Point site in May 2003. Since 1975, Turning Point has provided compassionate care to more than 35,000 clients working to overcome alcoholism, substance abuse and their co-occurring disorders.

Our goal is not only to help our clients cope with their addictions, but also to help them develop the tools to manage the challenges and opportunities of their everyday lives. Whether in one of our residential treatment facilities or outpatient programs, clients find a safe place to face their dependencies—head on. They receive the highest quality clinical care from a dedicated and multi-disciplinary staff.

Whom we serve

Turning Point provides care to all those seeking sobriety and recovery, regardless of their ability to pay. We accept most major insurance plans and have a sliding fee scale for those without insurance.



What we do

Turning Point's goal is to teach clients the life skills they need to remain alcohol and drug free. Our program is grounded in the belief that a supportive, structured and non-judgmental environment is necessary for individuals to begin the journey to sobriety and recovery.

Utilizing a holistic approach, we provide services that focus on the whole person. We endeavor to address the physical, psychological, social and spiritual effects of addiction. Each client receives an individualized course of treatment that combines the traditional Twelve Step model with individual, group and family counseling, education groups, and other interventions.

What we provide

Our services include:

- Medically-monitored detoxification
- Medication management and education
- A gender-specific approach to care
- Family orientation
- Self-Help Support Groups
- Stress management
- Relapse prevention
- Short-term residential and long-term residential care
- Outpatient and Intensive Outpatient treatment
- Family support programs and groups
- Aftercare referrals

Special programs include detoxification from alcohol and opiates, treatment for pregnant and postpartum women, and treatment for those suffering from co-occurring substance use and mental health disorders.
